## Steps to Apply to Global Exchange

- 1. **Research the <u>UCSD Global Exchange programs</u>**. Be sure to review course offerings to find a program that meets your academic needs.
- 2. **Review** program specific information such as housing, cost, dates and other useful information to identify a program that aligns with your academic and personal goals.
- 3. **Review** your degree audit for remaining UCSD academic requirements. Identify courses you plan to take abroad using the course information provided on the UCSD Global Exchange program page(s).
- 4. **Meet** with your UCSD academic advisors (major=department advisor/GEs=College advisor). Ask your advisors about fulfilling UCSD requirements with the courses you plan to take abroad. Be sure to have course information ready to share, if needed.
- 5. Check the <u>UCSD Global Exchange deadlines page</u> for nomination deadlines and program status. When a program is full, it will be noted.
- 6. Confirm that you meet the eligibility requirements BEFORE you apply for a program.
- 7. **Ask any questions** you have by connecting with Study Abroad UC San Diego. Visit our <u>Advising Services</u> page for information.
- 8. Complete the UCSD Global Exchange Nomination Form no later than the deadline.
- 9. Check your email regularly. You will be notified approximately 2 weeks after the deadline if you have been nominated for the program.
- 10. If nominated, you will be given the next steps in the application process which will include completing an application in Tritons Abroad and a host university application.
