How to Receive Financial aid for Global Seminars



Step 1

Apply for the Global Seminars Program. Enroll for summer classes online in April.



Step 2

Once enrolled, you may use the Financial Aid online Summer application located on TritonLink. Remember aid is limited so the sooner you register the sooner you will be able to apply for summer aid.



Step 3

You will be notified by financial aid to accept your summer aid package.



Step 5

If you receive aid, the money will be applied to your student account. If there is money left over it will be deposited into your bank account (via direct deposit) or a check will be issued.

- Parent Contribution	\$11,089 <i>(\$73,928 annual)</i>
- Student Contribution	\$0 <i>(\$100 annual)</i>
= Need	\$0
- Direct Subsidized Loan	\$0
- Direct Unsubsidized Loan*	\$0 <i>(up to \$7000 if not used during academic yr)</i>
- Direct PLUS Loan (Parent Loan)**	\$10,693 <i>(up to total cost – requires credit approval)</i>

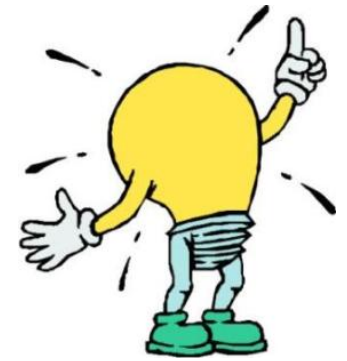


*Maximum Direct Unsubsidized Loan for Independent students = \$7000 or \$12,500 Direct Subsidized/Unsubsidized

**Direct PLUS Loan/Private Loan for Dependent students, Private Loan only for Independent students

†Late FAFSA Filers are not eligible for UC Grant; apply for summer financial aid early, limited funding

Key Info to Remember



- Summer aid is limited, so be sure to apply as soon as possible
- If you do not receive enough financial aid, to pay for your UC fees you must pay the difference by the due date, or else you will be dropped from the program
