fare types/routing

Basic, Regular and Premium Economy

- Basic economy fares are the cheapest you can find
 - No baggage included without paying extra at check-in
 - Often non-changeable and non-refundable
- Regular or standard economy is more expensive than basic but also more flexible
 - 1-2 bags included, depending on the route and airline
 - Often changeable, but not always refundable
 - Some of our exclusive fares are refundable and cheaper than published rates
- Premium economy is more expensive than regular and includes extra legroom


Round Trip, Multi-City or One Way

- Round-trip into a single destination, including a return from the same city
 - Dallas to London to Dallas
- Multi-city is flying into one destination and out of another
 - Dallas to London/London to Paris/Paris to Dallas
- One-way is a single ticket, moving you in one direction
 - Dallas to London




when to buy

- Wait until you are accepted into the program
- Book sooner, rather than later
 - Airlines calculate fares based advance purchase rules
 - Our student fares are based on availability and could sell out, even if there are seats open
- March-June is the busiest period of the year for travel bookings
- Global events can greatly impact the cost of travel



choose travel dates

- It's often cheapest to travel on a Monday or Tuesday.
- If you have to fly over a weekend (Friday-Sunday) look for a red-eye flight if you can, as they're usually cheaper.





Mixed carrier tickets

- If you are looking at a ticket that uses multiple airlines make sure the airlines are in the same alliance or that they partner together.
 - Alliances: Skyteam (Delta), One World (American), Star Partners (United)
- Mixed Carriers who do not partner together might not protect you if you are delayed.
- - Mixed carriers who don't partner together may charge you additional baggage fees

things to consider

- Carefully review your itinerary to try and avoid long layovers which can be costly.
- Non-stop or connecting
- Layover times
 - 1 hour domestic, 2 hours international
- Agent assistance or web booking: an agent can help you with the small print of airfare contracts and can point out short layovers, etc.
